Dudley, Wolverhampton, Walsall and Tamworth Junction Railway.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the next session, for an Act or Acts to authorize the construction of the railway hereinafter described, or some part or parts thereof, together with all proper works, approaches, and conveniences connected therewith, that is to say, a railway commencing by a junction with the line of the Grand Junction Railway at or near Bescott Bridge, in the parish of Walsall and county of Stafford, passing thence from, in, through, or into the several parishes, townships, and extra-parochial and other places following, or some of them, that is to say, Walsall, Walsall Foreign otherwise the Foreign of Walsall, Walsall Borough, St. Peter's, Walsall, Bloxwich, Great Bloxwich, Harden, Birchills, Bescott, the Pleck Woodend, Colmore Millfurlong, Walsall Racecourse, the Long Meadows Walsall, Lammas Lands, Ryecroft, Carthridge, Coal Pool, Shaver's End, Rushall, Aldridge, Mill Green, Aston otherwise Little Aston, Ashton otherwise Little Ashton, Shenstone, Stonnall, Lower Stonnall and Thorne's Over Stonnall and Lynn, Woodend and Fotherley, Little Hay, Weeford, Thickbroom, Packington, Swinfen, Canwell, Hints, Fazeley, Bonehill and Bangley, Dunstall, Millfield, Staffordshire Moor, Comberford, Coton, Hopwas and Wigginton, Hopwas Wood, Tamworth, Tamworth Borough, Castle Trust, King's Ditch, Bolehall and Glascote in the county of Stafford; and Tamworth, Tamworth Borough, Castle Trust, King's Ditch, Bolehall and Glascote in the county of Warwick; and terminating either by a junction with the Birmingham and Derby line of the Midland Railway, at or near a certain station thereon, called the Tamworth station, in the parish of Tamworth aforesaid, and counties of Stafford and Warwick, or one of the said counties, or otherwise terminating by a junction with the line of the Trent Valley Railway, as authorized to be made by an Act passed in the last session of Parliament, in the parish of Tamworth, and counties of Stafford and Warwick aforesaid, or one of them.

divert, for the purpose of the said intended works, or any of them.

And it is also intended to apply for powers to vary or extinguish all existing rights or privileges in any manner connected with the lands proposed to be purchased or taken for the purposes of the said undertaking, or any part thereof, or any of the works connected therewith, or which would in any manner impede or interfere with the construction, maintenance, or use thereof, or of any part thereof, and to confer other rights and privileges.

And it is also intended by the said Act or Acts to incorporate a company for the purpose of carrying the said intended undertaking, or any part thereof, into effect, and to take powers for the purchase of lands or houses, by compulsion or agreement, for the purposes thereof or of any part thereof, and for levying tolls, rates, and duties for and in respect of the use of the same or any part thereof, and to grant certain exemptions from such tolls, rates, and duties.
