WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of an Act, passed in the session of Parliament held in the third and fourth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled " An Act to carry into effect, with certain " modifications, the fourth report of " Commissioners of Ecclesiastical Duties and " Revenues;" and of another Act, passed in the session of Parliament held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled " An Act " to explain and amend two several Acts relating " to the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England," duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a scheme, bearing date the thirteenth day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, in the words following, that is to say;

"Whereas, under the provisions of the said Acts, the whole of the property now belonging to the dignity or office of treasurer in any cathedral church in England (excepting any right of patronage) will, upon the first avoidance of such dignity or office, become absolutely vested in us for the purposes of the said Acts; and the chief of such
