

Thereafter the Meeting proceeded to the election of Scrutineers, when Messrs. Henry Guthrie Wright, Andrew Macgeorge, junior, and Thomas Adair, before designed, were elected to that office, to take the votes of the Shareholders, and verify the same in the terms of the Act.

The Chairman then put to the Meeting the question, whether the Company shall be dissolved; and the votes being taken and marked, it was found and declared by the Scrutineers, that persons representing one thousand eight hundred and fifty of the shares in said Undertaking or Company, actually issued or given before the 31st day of March 1846, either as Shares, Scrip, or Receipts, being

the requisite quorum prescribed by the Act, voted for the dissolution of the Company, the number of shares issued being 2630.

It was resolved accordingly, that the said Company be dissolved in terms of the said Act, and that the necessary steps be taken forthwith for carrying this resolution into effect.
