The Queen has been pleased to grant unto the Right Honourable Henry Walker (formerly Henry Flower) Viscount Ashbrook, in that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called Ireland, Her royal licence and authority, that he and his issue may henceforth take and use the surname of Flower, in lieu of their present surname of Walker, and also bear the arms of Flower, in lieu of those of Walker; such arms being first duly exemplified according to the laws of arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office, otherwise the said licence and permission to be void and of none effect:

And also to command, that the said royal concession and declaration be registered in Her Majesty's College of Arms.
