Arbuthnot and Co. Agents of Mrs. Mary Wheatly, the mother, and of Mr. John Wheatly, one of the brothers of the deceased, the same being their respective one sixth shares as aforesaid; the sum of C. rs. 926 10 2 has been paid to Messrs. Binny and Co. Agents of Farrier Thomas Wheatley, one other brother of the deceased, and of Serjeant J. F. Lincoln, in right of his wife, Mrs. Sarah Lincoln, one of the sisters of the deceased, the same being their respective one sixth shares as aforesaid; the sum of C. rs. 463 5 1, being the share of the late Mrs. Ann Redsall, one other sister of the deceased, has been invested in two Government securities, amounting to C. rs. 426, purchased for the sum of C. rs. 421 8 3, and the same has been deposited in the Honourable Company's Treasury to the credit of this estate, in trust, for Mr. Redsall, in right of his wife, Mrs. Ann Redsall, and the balance in cash, viz. C. rs. 41 12 10, is retained in my hands, it being too small a sum for investment; the sum of C. rs. 463 5, forthcoming to the late Mrs. Charlotte Milton, one other sister of the deceased, has been divided into two equal shares.
