Her Majesty, having taken the said representation, together with the map thereunto annexed, into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve thereof; and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the proposed formation into one consolidated chapelry be accordingly made, and the agreement, in respect of the right of presentation or appointment of an incumbent or perpetual curate to serve the said church and consolidated chapelry, be carried into effect, agreeably to the provisions of the said Acts.
