**I**N pursuance of the directions of an Act, passed in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled "An Act to repeal so much of two Acts, made in the tenth and fifteenth years of the reign of His present Majesty, as authorizes the Speaker of the House of Commons to issue his warrants to the Clerk of the Crown for making out writs for the election of Members to serve in Parliament, in the manner therein mentioned, and for substituting other provisions for the like purposes:"

I do hereby nominate and appoint Ralph Bernal, Esq. the Right Honourable Robert Grosvenor, commonly called the Right Honourable Lord Robert Grosvenor, Sir William Heathcote, Bart. William Ord, Esq. Thomas Greene, Esq. and Thomas William Bramston, Esq. being Members of the House of Commons, or any one or more of them, to issue warrants to the Clerk of the Crown, in cases in the said Act specified.
