

condition of such corporation, university, college, person or persons contributing to the permanent endowment of such minister or perpetual curate, or towards providing a church or chapel for the use of the inhabitants of such district or new parish, in such proportion and in such manner as shall be approved by the like authority:

“ And whereas a church or chapel has been erected by the aid of certain monies contributed by the trustees of a fund, called “ The Metropolis Churches Fund,” within each of the said districts of the Holy Trinity, Hoxton, Saint Matthew, City-road, and Saint Mark, Old-street, herein recommended to be constituted, and it is intended that such churches or chapels shall be consecrated, as the churches or chapels of such districts respectively, for the use and service of the ministers and inhabitants thereof; and the said trustees have nominated to us the Bishop of London, for the time being, as the patron in perpetuity of each of the said districts :

“ We, therefore, further recommend and propose, that the right of patronage of and the nomination of the minister or perpetual curate to each of the said districts or new parishes of the Holy Trinity, Hoxton, and Saint Matthew, City-road, and Saint Mark, Old-street, shall be assigned to, and may from time to time be exercised by, the said Charles James Bishop of London, and his successors Bishops of London for ever.

“ And we further recommend and propose, that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, or of any other Act of Parliament.

“ SCHEDULE.

“ No. 1.—The district of **THE HOLY TRINITY, HOXTON**, being—

“ All that part of the district parish of Saint John the Baptist, Hoxton, being part of the original parish of Saint Leonard, Shoreditch, in the county of Middlesex, and in the diocese of London, situate on the western side of an imaginary line extending southward from the Regent’s Canal along the western boundary of the district of Christ Church, Hoxton, in the said county and diocese, and along the middle of Croyley-street, Stanley-street, Provost-street, and Plumber-street, as far as the eastern end of Ebenezer-street, and on the northern side of an imaginary line extending westward from Plumber-street aforesaid, along the middle of Ebenezer and Collingwood streets.

“ No. 2.—The district of **SAINT MATTHEW, CITY-ROAD**, being—

“ All that part of the district of Saint Barnabas, King-square, in the parish of Saint Luke, Old-street, in the said county and diocese, situate on the northern side of an imaginary line extending eastward from the western boundary of such last-mentioned district, along the middle of Charles-

street, as far as the City-road, and thence towards the south east along the middle of the City-road aforesaid to a point (marked *a* on the map or plan hereunto annexed, and numbered 2.,) opposite to the middle of the Wharf-road, and thence towards the north east along the middle of such last-mentioned road as far as Edward-street, and thence eastward along the middle of such street to the boundary of the said district of Saint Barnabas, King-square.

“ No. 3.—The district of **SAINT MARK, OLD-STREET**, being—

“ All that part of the said parish of Saint Luke, Old-street, and also all that part of the said parish of Saint Leonard, Shoreditch, and also all that part of the said district parish of Saint John the Baptist, Hoxton, comprised within and bounded by an imaginary line commencing at a point (marked *a* on the map or plan hereunto annexed, and numbered 3.,) in the middle of Old-street, and opposite to the middle of Bunhill-row, and thence extending eastward along the middle of such street as far as the City-road, and thence northward along the middle of such road to the boundary of the said parish of Saint Luke, Old-street, and thence towards the north west along such boundary as far as the middle of Baldwin-street, and thence eastward along the middle of such last-mentioned street to the City-road aforesaid, and thence southward along the middle of such road to a point (marked *b* on the last-mentioned map or plan) opposite to the middle of the street or roadway between Winckworth-place, Craven-buildings, Charles-place, Baches-row, and Brunswick-place, and thence eastward along the middle of such street or roadway, and the northern side of Charles-square, and along the middle of Queen-street as far as Pitfield-street, and thence southward along the middle of such last-mentioned street, across the Old-street-road and Tabernacle-square, to the northern end of Paul-street, and thence continuing in the same direction along the middle of such last-mentioned street as far as the middle of Leonard-square, and thence westward along the middle of Leonard-street to the north eastern corner of the district of Saint Paul, Finsbury, and thence also westward along the northern boundary of such district as far as Bunhill-row, and thence northward along the middle of Bunhill-row aforesaid, to the point where the said imaginary line commenced.”

And whereas the draft of the said scheme has been transmitted to the incumbents and to the patrons of the churches of the parishes, and to the incumbent and patron of the church or chapel of the district, out of which it is intended that the districts therein recommended to be constituted shall be taken, pursuant to the provisions of the said Act; and such incumbents and patrons have respectively consented to the said scheme :
