in the said schedules marked A 3., B., and C., the fixed annual sum set opposite to the name of such benefice or church in the last column of the said schedule, on the first day of May and the first day of November in each year; and that the first such half-yearly payment shall in each case be made on the first day of May next, except in the cases of the vicarages of Saint John Buckhurst-hill, Chigwell, and Hurstborne Tarrant with Verham Dean, and the perpetual curacy of Weeford and Hints, the incumbents whereof shall, on such last-mentioned day, receive three such half-yearly payments, and except also in the cases of the district church of Saint Barnabas King'ssquare, in the parish of Saint Luke's, London, and the vicarages of Chard and Llansaintfraid yn Mechan, the incumbents whereof shall, on such last-mentioned day, receive two such half-yearly payments; and that, in case of a vacancy in any of the benefices or churches contained in the said three schedules having already happened during the period over which the payment so recommended and proposed extends, or hereafter happening on any other day than the first day of May or the first day of November, the amount payable shall be duly apportioned between and paid to the incumbent making the vacancy, or his personal representatives, and the incumbent succeeding to the benefice or church so becoming or having become vacant.

"Provided that, in the cases of the vicarages of Chard, Hurstborne Tarrant with Vernham Dean, and Sonning, the respective payments shall be made only on the production to us, or to our treasurer and secretary, on or before the first day of May and first day of November respectively in this and every succeeding year, of a certificate, under the hand of the bishop of the diocese, that a curate, licensed by such bishop,

of each of the benefices and churches so described | has been duly employed at Tatworth, in the in the said schedules marked A 3., B., and C., parish of Chard, at Vernham Dean, and at Early, the fixed annual sum set opposite to the name of in the parish of Sonning.

"And whereas we have satisfied ourselves, that the several benefices contained in the schedule hereunto annexed, marked E., fall within the third class aforesaid; we, therefore, recommend and propose, that, in order to provide fit houses of residence for the incumbents of the benefices contained in the last-mentioned schedule, we shall be at liberty to pay, to such persons and at such times as shall appear to us from time to time to be expedient, such a sum or sums of money, in the case of each such benefice, as shall be required for providing a fit house of residence for the incumbent thereof.

" And we further recommend and propose, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the further augmentation of any of such benefices or churches, if it shall be deemed fit, when there shall be sufficient means for that purpose; and that if it shall appear to us to be expedient, at any future time, that instead of the annual sum then in course of payment by us to the incumbent of any benefice, or instead of any part of such annual sum, any land, tithe or other hereditament should be conveyed to such benefice in fee, nothing herein, or in any other scheme, contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing such a substitution; provided that no such change shall take effect before the then next vacancy of the benefice affected thereby, without the written consent of the then existing incumbent.

"And we further recommend and propose, that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measure for making better provision for the cure of souls, in conformity with the provisions of the said recited Acts, or either of them."
