

persons attacked by, or threatened with cholera, and who cannot be properly treated in their own homes, may be conveyed.

5. We authorize and require the said Board of Guardians to provide houses of refuge to which may be removed the families of such necessitous persons as have been attacked with cholera, and also such necessitous persons living under the same roof, or in the vicinity of persons so attacked, as the medical officers acting under the authority of the said parochial board may deem it necessary to remove, the houses, rooms, or dwellings from which persons may have been so removed to the houses of refuge, to be cleansed and purified by the owners or persons having the care or ordering thereof, or in their default by the said parochial board.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Bideford Union, Devon, and to all others whom it may concern.

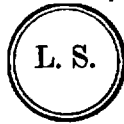
Whereas by the Act eleventh and twelfth Victoria, cap. 123, intituled "An Act to renew and amend an Act of the tenth year of Her present Majesty for the more speedy removal of certain nuisances, and the prevention of contagious and epidemic diseases," and by virtue of an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 27th day of March 1849, directing that the provisions of the said Act be continued in force throughout the whole of Great Britain; We, the General Board of Health, are authorized to issue such directions and regulations as the said Board shall think fit, for the prevention, as far as possible, or mitigation of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases;

And whereas we have been informed that a vessel lately arrived in the port of Bideford having cholera on board;

We, the General Board of Health, do hereby order and require that the Guardians of the Poor of the Bideford Union shall, by themselves or their officers, enter the said vessel, or any other vessel coming into the said port in which cholera or other epidemic disease has occurred, and

examine the sanitary condition of the same, and inquire into the health of the crew or crews, and, if need be, order cleansing, purification, and all other necessary measures for the prevention of disease, which are authorized or required to be adopted in any dwellings on land by the General Regulations of the Board, of the 3rd and 18th of November 1848, issued to the Guardians of the Poor throughout England and Wales.
