ments, cuttings, weirs, sluices, drains, and other works, connected with the said reservoirs respectively; also to make and maintain an aqueduct or conduit, from a junction with the aqueduct or conduit first described, at or near the junction of a lane leading from a place called the Slade to Child's Hill, with the said turnpike-road from London to Watford, in the parish of Hendon, in the county of Middlesex, and passing thence wholly through, and terminating in the said parish of Hendon, in the county of Middlesex, at the said reservoir on Child's Hill above mentioned; and another aqueduct or conduit from the lastmentioned reservoir, passing thence from, through, or into the several parishes of Hendon and Saint John, Hampstead, or one of them, in the county of Middlesex, and terminating in and at the beforementioned reservoir, on Hampstead Heath; also to make and maintain a reservoir or reservoirs, on the north side of, and near, or adjoining the said road, leading from Elstree to Chipping Barnet, at a certain place about a quarter of a mile to the west of the turnpike-road, from London to Saint Albans, in the parish of Elstree, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford; also to make and maintain an aqueduct or conduit, commencing by a junction with the first described aqueduct or conduit, at or near the tenth-mile-stone on the turnpike-road from London to Saint Albans, in the parish of Little Stanmore, in the county of Middlesex, passing thence from, through, or into the parishes, townships, extraparochial, or other places of Little Stanmore, and Edgeware, in the county of Middlesex, and Elstree, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford, and terminating near the church, in the village and parish of Elstree, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford; also to make and maintain an aqueduct or conduit, commencing by a junction with the last-men-tioned aqueduct or conduit at or near a certain point where the road from Elstree to Chipping Barnet joins the turnpike-road from London to Saint Albans, in the said village and parish of Elstree, and county of Hertford, and passing thence from, through, or into the parishes, townships, extra-parochial, or other places of Elstree, Ridge, and Chipping Barnet, or some or one of them, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford, and Shenley, in the county of Hertford, and the parishes, townships, extra-parochial, or other places of Edgeware, Hendon, Had-ley, Monken Hadley, and South Mimms, in the county of Middlesex, and terminating at or near Hadley High Stone, in the parish of Hadley, otherwise Monken Hadley, in the county of Middlesex; also to make and maintain an aqueduct or conduit, commencing by a junction with the last-mentioned aqueduct or conduit, at or near the junction of the road from Elstree to Chipping Barnet, with the turnpike-road from London to Hatfield, in the parish of Chipping Barnet, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford, and passing thence from, through, or into the parishes, townships, extra-parochial, or other places of Barnet, Chipping Barnet, and East Barnet, or some or one of them, in the liberty of Saint Albans, in the county of Hertford, Totteridge in the county of Hertford, and Barnet, Totteridge, Whetstone, Fryern Barnet, Finchley, Hornsey, and Highgate, or some or one of them, in the county of Middlesex, and terminating at or near the point where the road from Highgate to Finchley joins the turnpike-road from Saint John's Chapel, in the parish of Saint Marylebone, to the north-east end of Ballard's-lane, sex, near to the said tavern, called Jack Straw's in the parish of Finchley, in the county of Middle-Castle, with all proper and necessary embank- sex; also to make and maintain an aqueduct or
