"3. That the patronage of the vicarage of Arlington, in the county of Sussex and diocese of Chichester, which is now vested in the prebendary of the Prebend of Woodhorne, in the cathedral church of Chichester, but which, upon the next vacancy of such prebend, would devolve on the Bishop of Chichester, be upon such vacancy transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of London and his successors.

"4. That the patronage, alternately with the Dean and Chapter of Canterbury, of the rectory of Saint Michael Paternoster with Saint Martin Vintry, in the city and diocese of London, and which said alternate patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Worcester; and the patronage, alternately with the Duke of Buccleugh, of the rectory of Saint Mary Somerset with Saint Mary Mounthaw, in the said city and diocese of London, and which said alternate patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Hereford; be transferred unto and henceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of London and his successors.

"5. That, upon the next avoidance of the see of Winchester, the patronage of the rectories of Bleadon and Rimpton respectively, in the county of Somerset, and in the diocese of Bath and Wells, and which said patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Winchester, be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of London and his successors.

"6. That, upon the next avoidance of the see of Winchester, the patronage, alternately with Her Majesty and her successors, in the following benefices, namely, the perpetual curacies of

Christchurch, Bermondsey,
Saint Paul, Bermondsey,
Saint Mark, Horsleydown,
Saint Andrew, Lambeth,
Saint Thomas, Lambeth,

all in the county of Surrey, and in the diocese of Winchester, and which said alternate patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Winchester, be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of London and his successors.

"7. That, upon the next avoidance of the see of Winchester, the patronage of the vicarage of Newchurch with Ryde, in the Isle of Wight, in the diocese of Winchester, and which said patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Gloucester and Bristol, shall be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Winchester and his successors.

"8. That the patronage of the several benefices comprised in the Table III., hereinafter set forth, and which said patronage is now vested in the archbishop and bishops respectively whose names are, in the said Table III. set opposite to the names of the said benefices, be transferred unto and henceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Oxford and his successors.
