exigent, escheats, reliefs, heriots, fealties, services, warrens, mines, quarries, furze, heaths, commons, moors, wastes, marshes, turbaries, waters, water-courses, streams, wears, banks, stanks, floodgates, fishings, winnowing places, hawking, hunting, and all other royalties, privileges, profits, and advantages whatsoever to the said several manors or lordships respectively belonging or in anywise appertaining, or therewith used or enjoyed.
