RENEWAL ORDER.-ENGLAND AND WALES.

To Local Boards of Health acting under the Public Health Act, 1848;

- To Town Councils or other Bodies acting under the Authority of Local Acts of Parliament in which the Provisions of the Public Health Act are included ;
- To the Guardians of the Poor of the several Unions in England and Wales named in the First and Third Schedules hereunto annexed;
- To the Guardians of the Poor of the several Parishes in England and Wales, named in the Second Schedule hereunto annexed;
- To the Overseers of the Poor of all Parishes, Townships, and Places not comprised in the Unions and Parishes mentioned in the Schedules hereunto annexed ;
- To the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of Cities and Boroughs, Commissioners under Local Acts, the Surveyors of Highways, their Deputies and Assistants, Road Trustees, Commissioners, County Surveyors, and other Persons by Law intrusted with the Care and Management of all Streets, public Ways and Places in any Parish or Place in England and Wales;
- To the Owners and Occupiers of Houses, Dwellings, Churches, Buildings, and Places of Assembly within the said Unions and Parishes, and others having the Care and Ordering thereof ; And to all whom it may concern ;—

WHEREAS by the provisions of "The Nuisances Removal and Diseases Prevention Act, 1848," for the prevention of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases, We, the General Board of Health, are authorized to issue such Directions and Regulations as we shall think fit for the prevention (as far as possible) or mitigation of epidemic, endemic, or contagious disease : And whereas by the said Act it is provided that the Directions and Regulations to be issued as aforesaid shall extend to all parts or places in which the said provisions of the said Act shall for the time being be in force, under the Order of Her Majesty's Privy Council, unless such Directions or Regulations shall be expressly confined to some of such parts or places, and then to such parts or places as in such Directions and Regulations shall be specified :


And whereas by an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 15th day of September, 1853, the said provisions of the said Act were directed to be put in force throughout the whole of Great Britain for a period of six calendar months thence next ensuing :

And whereas We, the General Board of Health, did under the Authority of the said Order issue certain Regulations and Directions as aforesaid, bearing date the 20th day of September, 1853, and certain other Regulations and Directions, bearing date the 12th day of October, 1853 :

And whereas by an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 10th day of March, 1854, the said firstmentioned Order was renewed for a further period of six calendar months thence next ensuing :

Now, in exercise of the Authority vested in us as aforesaid, We, the said General Board of Health, do hereby renew the said Directions and the 12th day of October, 1853, for such time as the said renewed Order shall continue in force.

RENEWAL ORDER. - (SCOTLAND.) To the Parochial Boards of the several Parishes

- and Combinations throughout Scotland;
- To all Magistrates of Burghs; Town Councils; Commissioners of Police; Trustees or Commissioners having the charge of the Paving of Streets ; Trustees having the charge of Turn-pike Roads and other Highways ; Trustees or Commissioners having the charge of Docks, Ports, or Harbours; Inspectors, Surveyors, or other Officers acting under such Magis-trates, Town Councils, Commissioners, and Trustees; and all other Persons intrusted by Law with the care and management of the Streets and Public Ways and Places throughout Scotland:
- To the Procurators Fiscal, and other Persons authorized to conduct Prosecutions before the Local Courts in Scotland;
- To the Owners and Occupiers of Houses, Dwellings, Churches, Buildings, and Places of Assembly, and others having the care and ordering thereof, throughout Scotland;

And to all whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by the provisions of the "Nuisances Removal and Diseases Prevention Act, 1848," for the prevention of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases, and by virtue of an Order of the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 15th day of September, 1853, directing that the said provisions of the said Act be put in force throughout the whole of Great Britain, We, the General Board of Health, are authorized to issue such Directions and Regulations as We shall think fit for the prevention (as far as possible) or mitigation of epidemic, endemic, or contagious diseases : And whereas by the said Act it is provided that the Directions and Regulations to be issued as aforesaid shall extend to all parts or places in which the said provisions of the said Act shall for the time being be in force under the Order of Her Majesty's Privy Council, unless such Directions or Regulations shall be expressly confined to some of such parts or places, and then to such parts or places as in such Directions and Regulations shall be specified :

And whereas We the said General Board did, under the authority of the said Order, issue certain Directions and Regulations, bearing date respectively the 24th and the 29th days of Sep-tember, and the 18th day of October, 1853, to extend to Scotland, and be in force throughout that part of the United Kingdom :

And whereas by an Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, bearing date the 10th day of March, 1854, the said first-mentioned Order was renewed for a further period of Six Calendar Months thence next ensuing :

Now, in exercise of the authority vested in us, Regulations of the 20th day of September, and of as aforesaid, We, the said General Board of
