Naples, June 22. The Marquis *del Carpio* our Viceroy, has received a very ample Power from the Court of *Spain* to order as he shall think fit, the execution of the Project concerning the new Money which has been so long talked of. We have advice that the *Pyrats* of *Barbary* have landed in this Kingdom near *Barletta*, where they plundered and burnt several Houses, and carried away with them about 60 prisoners. Three Gallies of the Duke of *Turris* Squadron are arrived in this Port, to take on board some Soldiers and Provisions; the other three remain at *Caera.*

Genova, July 6. The four Gallies that sailed from hence the 21 of the last Month, to clear this Coast of the *Turkish* Brigantines we had advice were cruising off of *Corsica*, are come back without hearing any news of them. The Master of a Vessel arrived from the *Levant* reports, that the *Venetians* have taken several *Turkish* Vessels laden with Provisions from *Alexandria.*

Leghorne, June 26. The *Algerines* have taken several Merchants Ships on these Coasts, whom they surprized by carrying *Dutch* Colours; They have likewise taken two Barks belonging to *Genova* and
