East Somerset Railway.

(Alteration of Line through Sir Edward Strode's Estate, in the parish of West Cranmore.)

(Transfer or Lease of the Wolverhampton Waterworks to the Wolverhampton New Waterworks Company; Amendment of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the present session, for a Bill to authorise the Wolverhampton New Waterworks Company to purchase or acquire, or to take on lease in perpetuity or for a term of years, and either immediately or from some past or future period, the whole undertaking of the Wolverhampton Waterworks Com-
