Rome, Decemb. 25. HE Pope does not yet give Audience. The Duke of Modena, who has been fome time here, is gone to take the diversion of Hunting at la Marfiliana, where He has been very magnificently Entertained by Cardinal Barberin. The Cardinals Ludovifis and Crefcen so, have been dangeroufly ill, but are at prefent fomewhat better. The Pope has taken off the Impofition that was raifed upon Provisions, which was farmed at 65 thousand Crowns. Prince Louis of Neuburgh, Great Malter of the Teutonicke Order, and the two Princes of R dzevil, Nephews to the King of Poland, are arrived here, and will remain Incognito till they can have Audience of the Pope. Father Marine, Vicar-general of the Jefuits, has fummoned an Affemby of the Society, to be held in the month of June for the chooling of a new General,

Nuples, Dec. 22. The Projects about the new Money have not yet been put in Execution, by reafor the Forreign Merchants will not furnish the Bars of Silver, but upon Conditions which our Viceroy does not approve of. The Lieutenant-General of the Lumenburgh Forces in the Service of the Republick of Venice, arrived here fome days ago from the Morea, and is gone from hence to Rume. We have advice by the Velfel that brough him hither, that the Serafquier of the Morea having drawn together a Body of between 6 and 7000 Horfe, had advanced under the Cannon of Corm, and fent 'a Summous to the Garifon to furrender the place; But underflanding afterward that. Captain-General Merofini was come to Coron, he prefently retired. They write from Palerm, that there has been a great Inundation in that Kingdom, which has done a great deal of harm.

Venice, January 4. This week arrived - here a Veffel from Coron, the Master whereof reports, that the Fortifications of that place were quite re-paired, and the Garilon very well provided for its defence. That the Msinotes, who together formed a Body of 6000 Men, made continual Incursions into the Turksh Territories, from whence they returued for the most part with advantage; and that among other Prisoners they had taken a Turkish Officer who offered 4000 Crowns for his Ranfom, but they in whole hands he was, demanded a much greater Sum. We have advice by Letters from Zara, that the Turks had lately burnt fcveral Houfes in the Neighborhood of that

place, and carried away about 40 Persons, with fome Cattle; And that they had gained with the promifes of great Rewards fome Morlaques, who had engaged to bring them the Head of the Chevalier Fanco under whom they ferved, but that their Treachery had been discovered, and they punished as they deferved. The Se+ nate have resolved to draw out all the. Garifons of Dalmatia, and fend them to the Morea, and to supply their places with the Militia of the Terra Firma ; With which, and the new raifed Troops that will be fent to the Marea, they pretend to have there the next Campagne an Army of above 30 thousand fighting Men. Commillions are daily given out for new Levies; And an Officer in the fervice of the Duke of Sproy, has agreed with the Senate, to raile 600 Ultramontaine Horse. The Baffa of Napoli di Romania, and his Brother, seem defirous to pass over to Barbary, not being able to support the great Expence they are here obliged to be at, to maintain their numerous Families.
