Sir,

Head Quarters of Artillery, Meerut, December 14, 1857.

IN obedience to instructions received from the office of the Adjutant-General of the Army, Fort William, I have the honor to forward a Nominal List of Non-commissioned Officers and Soldiers of the Regiment under my Command, who have been either killed or wounded, or have died since the commencement of the outbreak.

2. This list is, I regret to say, incomplete, as, owing to the interruption to dâk communication, no returns have been received from companies specified in the margin, stationed in Central India and the Lower Provinces. The casualties that may have occurred in these companies therefore have

not been included.

3. Nor, for the same reason, have I been able to furnish you with a list of casualties in the 1st Troop 1st Brigade, and 2nd Troop 3rd Brigade Horse Artillery, and the 3rd Company 1st Battalion of Foot, later than the 1st October last, these Troops and the Company having been detached from the Delhi Field Force on the fall of that place, and are now assisting in the operations at Lucknow.
