Mr Tucker positively refused to accompany them, and was therefore the following day the only European left in the station. The jail was broken and the treasury plundered at about 9 a.m., and an attack was made in the afternoon by a number of fanatic Mussulmans (headed by one Syud Mohumud Hosseen) on Mr. Tucker. Mr. Tucker took refuge on the roof of his cutcherry, and was able for some time to keep off his assailants: they however, eventually, set fire to the building, and under cover of the smoke, &c. succeeded in mounting the roof and despatching their victim. It appears that Mr. and Mrs. Collins left Cawnpore in the early part of June. They intended proceeding to Banda, and had reached Khujwa, when they were seized by the retainers of Nuwaub Amjud Ally Khan; they were taken to Bindhkee, and subsequently to the Nuwaub's own house at Hata Pergunneh Suppehjar, where they were kept prisoners for a week, and eventually foully murdered by the Nuwaub's orders about 15th June.
