DELIVERY OF SHIPS' MANIFESTS IN FRENCH PORTS.

A representation having been made to the Board of Trade that Ship-Masters trading to the Port of Dunkirk are in the habit of disregarding the imperial law which requires that the Master of every vessel trading to a French port shall have a manifest of cargo ready for delivery at the Custom House on arrival in port.

It is hereby notified to Masters and Owners of vessels trading to French Ports generally that the strictest attention is necessary to the above regulation, the neglect to comply with which may in future subject them to serious inconvenience.
