

les the next Summer. The King having receiv'd advice that Sultan *Galga* had drawn together the Troops he has now with him, not so much with a design to make an Incurſion into *Podolia*, as to conduct a Convoy of Proviſions to *Carnieec*, ſeveral Troops have been ordered that way, to oppoſe this deſign, and to block up yet cloſer that important place, the Garriſon whereof, which uſed to be compoſed of 9 or 10 thouſand Men, is, as we are well aſſured, at preſent reduced to 2500 Horſe, and 4000 Foot; and theſe are in a very ill condition through the want they have of Proviſions.

*Danzick*, March 12. They write from *Riga*, that ſeveral Perſons were arriv'd there from *Moscovy*, who reported, that the preparations that were making on that ſide, for the proſecuting the War againſt the *Turks* and *Tartars*, were very extraordinary. That the Czars had taken ſeveral Foreign Officers into their Service, and had ſent to *Germany* and other parts for more; and that the common diſcouſe was, they would have 200 000 Men in the Field the next Summer, which are to be commanded by *Kneaz Galtz*, their chief Miniſter, and Favorite. They write from *Poland*, that great Preparations are likewiſe making in that Kingdom, and that the Forces are appointed to be at the general Rendezvous, about the middle of *May*. There are Letters from *Lemberg* of the firſt of this month, which ſay, That a great Convoy of Proviſions and Ammunition, with a new Baſſa, was arriv'd at *Conſtance*, under the Guard of 20000 *Tartars*. The *Polish* Court is expected the next Month at *Warſaw*.

*Hamburg*, March 18. The Electors of *Brandenburgh* and *Saxony*, having written to this City in Favour of the *Sieurs Selm* and *Lander Linde*, who are now Priſoners here, accuſed of having been of the Conſpiracy with *Jasſeram* and *Snitzer*, the Senate has returned very reſpectful Answers to thoſe Prince, and ſeem at the ſame time to have given ſome ſtop to the Proceedings againſt the ſaid Priſoners. The King of *Denmark* has cauſed all the old Pieces of Cannon that were found at *Oldenburgh* and *Demmerhorſt*, to be carried to *Lubecke* to be new-caſt there. They write from *Zell* of the 16th Inſtant, That ſeveral Conferences have lately been held there between the Miniſters of the Dukes of *Luxenburgh*, and thoſe of divers other Princes; after which, the Duke of *Zell* went from thence to *Vaſen*, to take the Divertiſement of Hunting for 8 or 10 days. The ſame Advices ſay, That the *Sieur Schulerz* was returning home from *France*, without having concluded any thing in the matters he was ſent to negotiate at that Court. The Letters from *Dresden* of the ſame date tell us, That the Baron de *Gortz*, Envoy from the Duke of *Hoſtein Gottorpe* was arriv'd there, and had had Audience of his Electoral Highneſs. We are told from *Peſtdam*, That the Elector of *Brandenburgh* had not yet given a final Answer to the Demand made by the *Polish* Envoy of Succors againſt the *Turks*. Great Preparations are making at that Court for the Marriage of the Prince of *Mecklenburg* with the Princeſs of *Brandenburgh*.

*Cologne*, March 20. The Letters from *Hydelberg* of the 16th Inſtant inform us, that the Secretary of the Conde de *Villar Mayor*, Ambaſſador Extraordinary from the King of *Portugal* to the Elector Palatin, was arriv'd there to regulate, as 'twas believed, the Ceremonial of his Reception, for which great Preparations were made; the Ambaſſador intending to remain in the mean time at *Spire* or *Frankfurt*. The States of *Juliers* aſſembled at *Duſſeldorpe*, have granted 30 thouſand Crowns for a Preſent to the future Queen of *Portugal*. The Letters from *Strasburgh* tell us, that great quantities of

Materials were ſent from thence to the new Forts that are building at the Bridge of *Illooyghen*, and in the Iſle of *Germerſheim*, on which the *French* continue to work with ſo great diligence, that they will in a ſhort time have finiſhed them. The Prince of *Neubourg*, Great Maſter of the *Turonick* Order, is arriv'd at *Duſſeldorpe*, to viſit his Brother the Duke of *Juliers*.

*Hague*, March 25. The Prince of *Orange* is returned to *Dieren*, where his Highneſs intends to ſtay till the beginning of *May*. The States of *Holland* are ſtill aſſembled, but it's believed they will adjourn in two or three days. The Envoy of *Morocco* continues ſtill at *Amſterdam*, he has ſent his Interpreter hither, to deſire he may have liberty to make uſe of the firſt Convoy that goes from theſe Countries to the *Streights*, to transport to *Sulle* the Body of his Secretary, who lately died here, which the States have granted. The Prince of *Waldecke* intends to go this week to his Government of *Magſtricht*.

The Right Honourable the Lords Commiſſioners of the Treasury, have appointed One Year's Penſion for the poor Criples belonging to the Cheſt at *Chatham*, which will be paid on the 28th of April next.
