THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of the Moniteur, containing a French Imperial Decree, dated the 26th instant, the effect of which, taken in conjunction with a previous Decree, dated the 29th September last, is to bring into force from the 1st November the provisions of the new French Tariff, as respects all the articles of British origin or manufacture contained in the Schedule published by the Board of Trade in the Supplement to the London Gazette of the 23rd instant, down to the Article "Refined Sugar" inclusive, with the single exception of Cutlery, other than Surgical, Optical, and Philosophical Instruments.

The following is a complete List of the Articles to which the new Tariff will apply from and after the 1st November, specifying the rates of duty in each case :---
