PY virtue and in pursuance of the provisions of the Statute 20 and 21 Victoria, cap. 77, I, the Right Honourable Sir Cresswell Cresswell, Knight, Judge of Her Majesty's Court of Probate, with the concurrence of the Right Honourable Richard, Lord Westbury, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and of the Right Honourable Sir Alexander James Edmund Cockburn, Baronet, Lord Chief Justice of the Court of Queen's Bench, do repeal all Tables of Fees heretofore fixed and published in respect of Contentious Business in Her Majesty's said Court of Probate, and in lieu thereof, and with the concurrence aforesaid, and with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, signified to me by letter, dated the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, do hereby affix the annexed Tables of Fees to be taken in respect of Contentious Business in the said Court of Probate, by the officers of the said Court, and by the practitioners therein; and I do further direct that the aforesaid Tables of Fees shall be repealed on and after the first day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, and that the said annexed Tables of Fees shall take effect on and after the said first day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two.
