same immunities, privileges, and rights, that accorded to Tunisian proprietors; and for purpose the right of British subjects to hold moveable property being derived from the en ments founded upon the organic laws ("Aac Aman"), the said enactments are hereby firmed; and their observance being considnecessary for the more efficient protection of immoveable property held as aforestated, it been further agreed that they shall be maintai as a greater security for the due performance the condition's of the present Convention. they shall be furthermore entitled to all the im nities, privileges, and exemptions accorded, o be hereafter accorded, to the subjects or citi of the most favoured nation.

This Convention has been written in triplic consisting in seventeen Articles, besides the in duction, and contained in the preceding nine pages, to be signed by both parties, and to executed in the manner explained and clearly forth in its several provisions, having for ot the duration, confirmation, and maintenance amity between them. Dated on Saturday, twenty-sixth day of Rabi-el-Thany, one thous two hundred and eighty of the Hedjira, co sponding to the tenth of October, in the yes our Lord one thousand eight hundred and si three, at the Palace of the Goletta.
