E it remembered, that at the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace of our Lady the Queen, held at Devizes, in and for the said county of Wilts, on Tuesday, the fifth day of January, in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of our Sovereign Lady Victoria, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, before Sir John Wither Awdry, Knight, Chairman, Henry Alworth Merewether, Edward Dugdale Bucknall Estcourt, Esquires, and others, their Fellows, Justices of our said Lady the Queen, assigned to keep the Peace of the said Queen, in the county aforesaid; and also to hear and determine divers felonies, trespasses, and other misdemeanours done and committed in the said county, it is ordered as follows (that is to say):
