THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade have received from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a copy of the Commercial Treaty recently concluded between France and Sweden and Norway, together with a copy of the Tarifts of Import Duties into Sweden and Norway annexed to the Treaty, and of which Tariffs (which also apply to the same articles of British produce or manufacture) the following is a translation :-

## Duties on Imports into Sweden.

Tre conversion into French unities of the monies, weights, and measures of Sweden and Norway although intended to facilitate commercial operations, has not an official character. They are established upon the following bases :-
