

time rent-charges, for the twelve months ended the first day of October then last preceding, which account, after being allowed and approved by the said bishop, shall be deposited in the Registry of the Commissary Court for the parts of Surrey, in the diocese of Winchester; and that a proportionate part of the first of such yearly payments to the incumbent of the perpetual curacy of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, and to the incumbent of the perpetual curacy of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, respectively, calculated from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette, of any Order of your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme, shall be due to and receivable by each such incumbent upon the first day of January next following such publication as aforesaid.

And we further recommend and propose, that the incumbents of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, and of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, and each of them, and each of his assigns, shall as against the vicar for the time being of the said vicarage of the parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, and his assigns, and the estates and revenues of the same vicarage (but so far only as such estates or revenues shall consist of the tithes or commutation tithe rent-charges hereinbefore recommended and proposed to be vested in such vicar and his successors) have and be entitled to exercise all such and the like powers of entry, distress, and other remedies for compelling payment of the proportionate annual sums hereinbefore proposed to be secured to the incumbents of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, and of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, respectively, as landlords are by law entitled to have and exercise in respect of rent reserved upon a lease and in arrear, provided always, and with the consents of the said Charles Richard, Bishop of the said diocese of Winchester, and the said John Sutton Utterton, (testified as aforesaid), we further recommend and propose that the vicar for the time being of the said vicarage of the parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, shall not under the provisions of this scheme be accountable in any one year to the incumbent of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, for a greater amount than one equal fifth part, nor to the incumbent of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, for a greater amount than one equal fifth part of the net annual amount of the rectorial tithes or commutation tithe rent-charges, which shall have been actually received by him during the twelve months, in respect of which such payment is to be made, so that any such deficiency of receipts be a *bond fide* deficiency, and be duly accounted for to the satisfaction of the Bishop of Winchester for the time being, upon such rendering of account as is hereinbefore mentioned and provided for, but so nevertheless that if, any of the rectorial tithes or commutation tithe rent-charges so recommended and proposed to be vested in the vicar of the parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, as aforesaid, shall not be recovered or received by him in any one year in which they may be due and payable but shall be recovered or received by him in any subsequent year, one equal fifth part of the net amount of the same when so recovered or received as last aforesaid, shall thereupon be paid over to each of the incumbents of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, and of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, respectively.

And with the consent of the Reverend George Edmund Fox, the incumbent of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, tes-

tified by his having signed and sealed this scheme), we further recommend and propose, that the annual sum to be so paid to him and his successors by the vicar for the time being of the said parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, as aforesaid, shall be in lieu of and in full substitution for and discharge of the annual sum of fifty pounds now payable by us to the incumbent of the said new parish of Saint John Hale, under the provisions of an Order of your Majesty in Council, bearing date the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and also in lieu of and in full substitution for and discharge of the annual sum of fifty-five pounds now likewise payable by us to such last-mentioned incumbent under the provisions of an Order of your Majesty in Council, bearing date the twenty-third day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine.

And with the consent of the Reverend Henry Richard Julius, the incumbent of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, (testified by his having signed and sealed this scheme), we further recommend and propose, that the annual sum to be so paid to him and his successors by the vicar for the time being of the said parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, as aforesaid, shall be held to be in lieu of and in full substitution for and discharge of the annual sum of ninety-two pounds now payable by us to the incumbent of the said particular district of Saint Peter, Wrecclesham, under the provisions of an Order of your Majesty in Council, bearing date the seventeenth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-four.

And with the like consent of the said Charles Richard, Bishop of the said diocese of Winchester (testified by his having signed and sealed this scheme), we further recommend and propose, that all that part of the said parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, which is described in the first Schedule hereunto annexed (all which part, together with the boundaries thereof is delineated and set forth on the map of plan hereunto also annexed and numbered 1) shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme, be constituted and become and be a separate district for spiritual purposes, and that the same shall be named 'The District of Tilford.'

And with the consents of the said Charles Richard, Bishop of the said diocese of Winchester, and of the said John Sutton Utterton (testified as aforesaid), we further recommend and propose, that the minister of the said district of Tilford so recommended to be constituted shall be permanently endowed in manner following; that is to say, that so soon as a minister shall be appointed and duly licensed to such district, there shall be paid to him and his successors the annual sum of one hundred and fifty pounds (clear of all deductions except income or property tax, if any), on the first day of December in each and every year, and that such annual sum shall be due from and paid by the vicar for the time being of the said parish of Saint Andrew, Farnham, and shall be charged upon and issuing out of the residue of the tithes or commutation tithe rent-charges arising within the said parish of Farnham and hereinbefore recommended and proposed to be vested in the said vicar and his successors, which shall remain to the said vicar after payment as aforesaid of the two several fifth parts of the net amount of the same tithes or commutation tithe rent-charges which are hereinbefore made payable by the said vicar to the incumbents of the perpetual curacy
