THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade give notice, that the "Moniteur," of the 21st December last, contains a copy of the Treaty of Commerce concluded at Vienna on the 11th day of December, 1866, between France and Austria, which came into effect from the 1st January, 1867, and to which are annexed the following Amended Tariffs of Import and Export Duties, which will be equally applicable to British produce and manufactures in France and Austria respectively, from the period at which they are brought into force.

TARIFF A.—DUTY UPON IMPORTS INTO FRANCE.

ANNEXED TO THE TREATY OF COMMERCE CONCLUDED UPON THE 11TH OF DECEMBER, 1866, BETWEEN FRANCE AND AUSTRIA.
