#### ORDER AS TO APPEAL AGAINST ADOPTION OF THE ACT BY TEDDINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX.

WHEREAS a Resolution for the adoption of the Local Government Act, 1858, was, on the 22nd day of November last, passed by the parish of Teddington, in the county of Middlesex; and notice thereof, in writing, was given to me, as one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, as required by such Act, and appeal has been duly made to me against the validity of the vote for the adoption of the said Act; and inquiry has been directed into the matters therein alleged, and report made to me thereon by Arnold Taylor, Esq., the Inspector, appointed by me for that purpose:

Now, therefore, I, as one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, as aforesaid, do hereby make order with respect to the matters in question on such appeal, as follows, viz:—

That the said vote for the adoption of the Local Government Act, 1858, passed by the said parish of Teddington, in the county of Middlesex, on the 22nd day of November last, was invalid.
