publication of these presents in the London Gazette, pursuant to the provisions of the same Act, the said church of the parish of Bury aforesaid shall be and be deemed to be a rectory.

In witness whereof, we, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, have hereunto affixed our common seal, this twelfth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.
