

bents of the same benefice, all those tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, which are particularly described in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, to the use of the said Incumbent, and his successors, for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, so granted and conveyed by us as aforesaid, shall be and be held to be in lieu of, and substitution for, the yearly sums or stipends amounting together to fifteen pounds heretofore payable by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage in respect of property situate within the said parish, which formerly belonged to the bishoprick of Carlisle; and provided also that the Incumbent for the time being of the same benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the perpetual curacy of Waverton, in the county of Chester, and in the diocese of Chester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same benefice, all those tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, so granted and conveyed by us as aforesaid, shall be, and be held to be, in lieu of, and in substitution for, the yearly sum or stipend of sixty pounds, heretofore payable by us to the Incumbent, for the time being, of the said perpetual curacy, in respect of property within the parish
