LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1858.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF PARTS OF ACTS BY THE WATH-UPON-DEARNE IMPROVEMENT COMMISSIONERS (COUNTY YORK).

WHEREAS the Wath-upon-Dearne Commissioners, acting under and by virtue of the Wath-upon-Dearne Improvement Act (9 and 10 Vict., cap. 245), did, on the 16th day of March, 1868, adopt various parts, sections, and provisions of the Public Health Act, 1848, the Local Government Act, 1858, and the Local Government Act (1858) Amendment Act, 1861, within the district of the said Improvement Commissioners, that is to say: section 73 of the Public Health Act, 1848, and section 36 of the Local Government Act, 1858, and so much of section 84 of the Public Health Act, 1848, as is not repealed by section 75 of the Local Government Act, 1858, section 85 of the Public Health Act, 1848, section 75 of the Local Government Act, 1858, and section 22 of the Local Government Act, 1858, Amendment Act, 1861 (with respect to the powers for purchasing lands for the general improvement of the district); with respect to the powers for improving streets, bridges, buildings, &c., and making bye-laws relative thereto, and other general improvements in the district, the following sections of the Public Health Act, 1848, the Local Government Act, 1858, and the Local Government Act Amendment Act, 1861, that is to say, sections 115 and 116 of the Public Health Act, 1848, sections 34 and 35 of the Local Government Act, 1858, paragraph 4 of section 32 of the Local Government Act, 1858, sections 40 and 45 of the Local Government Act, 1858, so much of section 44 of the Local Government Act, 1858, as relates to the incorporated powers with respect to fires, and sections 28 and 29 of the Local Government
