

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Littlebourn, in the county of Kent, and in the diocese of Canterbury, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those tithe commutation rent charges, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that such tithe commutation rent charges shall be, and be held to be, in lieu of, and in full substitution for, the annual stipend of fifty pounds, heretofore payable by us to the Incumbent, for the time being, of the said vicarage, in respect of certain property within the parish of Littlebourn, formerly belonging to the Dean and Chapter of Canterbury: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges, as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.
