

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of the Holy Trinity, Arlington, otherwise the Dicker, in the county of Sussex, and in the diocese of Chichester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those annual tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent, and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent-charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of, and in substitution for, a portion amounting to two hundred and thirty-three pounds of the annual payments, together amounting to two hundred and thirty-five pounds, heretofore made by us the said Commissioners to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage, under and by virtue of certain Orders of Her Majesty in Council which were published in the London Gazette of the thirtieth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, and the tenth day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five respectively; and provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent-charges, as from the first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
