WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Fairford, in the county of Gloucester, and in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all that piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, which is particularly described in the first part of the Schedule hereunto annexed, and is now vested in us; and also all that our fee simple interest in reversion expectant on the determination of the subsisting lease thereof, in and to the tithe commutation rent charge, which is particularly described in the second part of such Schedule, to have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances, and also the said tithe commutation rent charge, subject to such subsisting lease thereof, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever.
