THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, from Her Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires at Madrid, copy of a Decree issued by the Spanish Government on the 17th instant, relative to the laws concerning anonymous Companies in Spanish Colonies.

The following are the Articles of this Decree:-

ART. 1. The Decree and Regulation of 19th October, 1853, concerning the constitution of anonymous Companies, the Royal Order of 8th September, 1857, and all Decrees and Orders subsequently issued on the same subject, are hereby abrogated in Cuba, Porto Rico, and the Philippines.

ART. 2. The Commercial Code is re-established in everything concerning the constitution and organization of anonymous Companies.

ART. 3. The Government inspection of the anonymous Companies now in existence shall cease six months after the publication of this Decree in the Official Gazettes of the Habana, Porto Rico, and Manila, to which end the Companies may, during the said space of time, make in their organization, statutes, and regulations, such reforms as the shareholders in general meeting may think proper.
