

and for this purpose a new series of the *Bulletino Industriale* is established.

2. The drawings which accompany the request for the issue of a patent must be either simply traced in Indian Ink, lithographed, or engraved, and must be as much reduced as possible, so as never to exceed the following dimensions:—

Either 15 centimetres by 20,
Or 20 „ by 30;

or, in cases of drawings of large machinery, 30 centimetres by 40.

3. Drawings larger than is strictly necessary for clearness will be returned by the Ministry of Commerce to the person asking for the patent; and he must then make fresh drawings not larger than the prescribed size. Until the fresh drawings have been duly presented no steps can be taken for granting the patent.

4. Articles 36 and 80 of the Law of January 31, 1864, are repealed.
