

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Gwersyllt, in the county of Denbigh, and in the diocese of Saint Asaph, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those annual tithe commutation rent charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of and in substitution for the annual stipend of forty pounds, heretofore payable by us or by our lessee to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage, in respect of certain property situate and arising within the parish of Gresford, in the county of Denbigh, formerly belonging to the dean and chapter of the cathedral church of Winchester: And provided also, that the said tithe commutation rent charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of and in substitution for the capital sum of eight hundred pounds and five shillings, heretofore held by us to the credit of the said vicarage, and in respect of which capital sum we have heretofore, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, published in the London Gazette of thirtieth October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty, made to the Incumbent of the said vicarage an annual payment of twenty-six pounds: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges, as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
