WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twentyninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Christ Church, Rossett, in the county of Denbigh, and in the diocese of Saint Asaph, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage all those title commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said title commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever : Provided always, that such title commutation rent-charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of and in substitution for the annual sum or stipend of fifty pounds, heretofore payable by us, to the Incumbent of the said vicarage, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, which was published in the London Gazette of the twelfth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges, as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this seventeenth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
