the export and transit of cattle, pigs, and sheep, as well as upon coal and coke, on the frontier.

The following are the Articles of this Decree:-

1. The prohibition of the export and transit of cattle, pigs, and sheep over the frontier from Nordhorn to Saarbrucken, both places inclusive, contained in Section 1 of the Ordinance of July 20 of the present year is removed.

2. The prohibition of the export and transit of coals and coke over the frontier from Memel to Saarbruck, both places included, contained in Section 1 of the Ordinance of July 16 of the present year, ceases to be in force as regards the frontier southwards from Malmedy to Saarbruck, inclusive.

THE Board of Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of a Despatch from Her Majesty's Minister at Washington, enclosing copy of an Act recently passed by the United States Legislature which enacts :--

- 1. That yachts belonging to a regularly organized yacht club of any foreign nation which shall extend like privileges to the yachts of the United States, shall have the privilege of entering or leaving any port of the United States without entering or clearing at the Custom-house thereof, or paying tonnage tax.
- 2. That United States yachts shall be furnished with a Commission by the Secretary of the. Treasury so that they may be identified in foreign ports.
