The cattle shall be conveyed, without stopping, from the Exhibition out of the Metropolis in properly constructed cattle-vans, or, if they are moved out of the Metropolis by railway, then they shall be conveyed in such cattle-vans, without stopping, to the railway-station, and there be transferred from such vans directly to the railway-truck.
- 4. If any such cattle, while in the Metropolis, come, accidentally or otherwise, in contact with any cattle other than cattle which have been exhibited at the Exhibition, they shall not be moved out of the Metropolis, but shall be slaughtered within its limits.
- 5. All cattle which are exhibited at the Exhibition, and are not moved out of the Metropolis under this Order, shall be slaughtered on or before the twenty-second day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
