

land, and in the diocese of Carlisle, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said rectory of Uldale, to meet such benefaction, one other capital sum of six hundred and twenty-five pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of providing a parsonage or house of residence for the said rectory, according to plans and a specification approved by us,

such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands, at interest after the rate of three pounds per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the Incumbent for the time being of the said rectory of Uldale.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this twentieth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of South Leigh, in the county of Oxford, and in the diocese of Oxford, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent-charges shall be and be held to be charged and chargeable at all times for ever hereafter in exoneration of all other property whatsoever now or formerly belonging to the bishoprick of Oxford, with the liability to repair and maintain the chancel of the church of the parish of South Leigh aforesaid: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent-charges, as from the first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
