LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1858.  
ORDER AS TO ADOPTION OF ACT BY TONG  
STREET DISTRICT, YORKSHIRE.

WHEREAS a resolution for the adoption of  
the Local Government Act, 1858, was, on the

25th day of February, 1871, passed by the town-  
ship of Tong, in the parish of Birstal, in the  
county of York. And whereas a memorial has  
been presented to me, as one of Her Majesty's  
Principal Secretaries of State, under the 17th
