

Rules, and Regulations made under that section should be enforced and executed;

And whereas by "The Local Government Board Act, 1871," all the powers vested in the Privy Council by (among other enactments) "The Sanitary Act, 1866," are transferred to and are to be exercised by the Local Government Board:

Now therefore, we, the Local Government Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on us by the above-named Acts, do hereby order and prescribe that, for the purposes of "The Sanitary Act, 1866," the harbour or roadstead of Penarth

shall be deemed to be within the district of the Cardiff Local Board of Health, and that the said Local Board shall be the authority by which the Order of Council dated July 29th, 1871, shall be enforced and executed with regard to ships coming into the said harbour or roadstead; or lying in the same.
