BY THE LORD CHANCELLOR.

WHEREAS by the sixteenth section of "The
Courts of Justice (Salaries and Funds) Act,
1869," it is provided that the Lord Chancellor,
with the advice and consent of the Lords Justices
of Appeal, Master of the Rolls, and Vice Chan-
cellors, or any three of them, and with the con-
currence of the Treasury, may, from time to time,
by order, increase, reduce, or abolish all or any of
the existing fees; and appoint new fees to be
taken in relation to proceedings in the Court of
Chancery, or in any of the offices mentioned in
the third schedule to the same Act: And whereas
the office of the Lord Chancellor's Secretary of
Presentations is one of the offices mentioned in
the said schedule, and it is expedient to appoint
new fees to be taken therein in lieu of the fees
now taken: Now, therefore, I, the Right Honour-
able William Page, Baron Hatherley, Lord High
Chancellor of Great Britain, with the advice and
consent of the Right Honourable John, Lord
Romilly, Master of the Rolls, and the Right
Honourable Sir William Milbourne James,
Knight, and the Right Honourable Sir George
Mellish, Knight, Lords Justices of the Court of
