

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England; acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of the Holy Trinity, Bromley, in the county of Kent, and in the diocese of Canterbury, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those tithe commutation rent charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us; to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of, and in full substitution for, an annual sum or stipend of fifty pounds, heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, to the Incumbent of the said vicarage, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, dated the tenth day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, and published in the London Gazette of the sixteenth day of the same month and year, to which substitution the Reverend Arthur Rawson, Clerk, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
