Considering the bad and very costly experiences of all Foreign Commissions at past London and Paris Exhibitions in storing empty packing cases, the Director-General of the Austrian Commission has made special arrangements in this respect, offering every possible facility. He has secured near the Exhibition grounds a large space for "empties," which he offers gratis to the Foreign Commissions. On this space a modern building will be erected, and a very moderate rate charged according to a fixed tariff based upon the actual outlay of cost. It will be connected by rail with the Exhibition buildings, so that all empties can be sent direct to this shed.

No previous Exhibition has afforded such facilities for this purpose.
