

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Iwade, in the county of Kent, and in the diocese of Canterbury, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all that the piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and also all those annual tithe commutation rent-charges, which said piece of land and annual tithe commutation rent-charges are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said land and annual tithe commutation rent-charges shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of, and in substitution for, the annual sum or stipend of eight pounds, heretofore payable by us, or by our lessee, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage, in respect of the said land and tithe commutation rent charges and other property formerly belonging to the archdeaconry of Canterbury, to which substitution the Reverend Morgan Thomas Pearman (Clerk), the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is a consenting party, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided further, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said land and annual tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-third day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this twenty-fourth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction of one hundred and five pounds sterling, which has been paid to us in favour of the vicarage of Saint Andrew, Wilmcote, in the county of Warwick, and in the diocese of Worcester, and in respect of which we have agreed to pay to the Incumbent of the same vicarage, and to his successors, a yearly sum of three pounds and ten shillings, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant to the In-
