TREASURY WARRANT.

WE, the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order and direct as follows:—

1. Every letter posted in Singapore addressed to Penang, or posted in Penang addressed to Singapore, transmitted direct by British packet-boat between Singapore and Penang, shall be charged, according to the weight thereof, with the rate or rates of British packet postage hereinafter mentioned, that is to say:—

If not exceeding one half of an ounce in weight

If exceeding one half of an ounce in weight, for the first half of an ounce, and for every additional half of an ounce or fractional part of half of an ounce ... Twopence.

2. This Warrant shall not prejudice or affect any exemptions or privileges granted by the Post Office Acts, nor the privileges enjoyed by seamen, soldiers, and others employed in Her Majesty's Service, of sending and receiving letters at a reduced rate of postage.

3. The rates of postage fixed by this Warrant shall be in lieu of those now chargeable for the sea conveyance of such letters as aforesaid, and shall be charged in addition to any Inland Colonial rates that may be payable thereon.

4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

THE FAIRS ACT, 1871.

HARPLEY FAIR.

IN pursuance of the above-mentioned Act, I, the Right Honourable Henry Austin Bruce, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, hereby notify as follows:

1. By Memorial, dated the 5th day of June, 1873, a representation has been duly made to me by the Justices sitting in Petty Sessions for the Hundred of Freebridge Lynn, in the county of Norfolk, that a Fair has been annually held on the 24th day of July, in the parish of Harpley, in the said division of the said county, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that such Fair should be abolished.

2. On the 16th day of July, 1873, I shall take the aforesaid representation into consideration, and all persons are to intimate, before that day, any objection they may desire to offer to the abolition of the said Fair.
