

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Dalston, in the county of Cumberland, and in the diocese of Carlisle, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all that piece or parcel of land and hereditaments with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and also all those annual tithe commutation rent-charges, which said piece or parcel of land and hereditaments and tithe commutation rent-charges, are particularly described in the schedules hereunto annexed, marked A and B respectively, and are now vested in us; to have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land and hereditaments with the appurtenances, and the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this twelfth day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.
